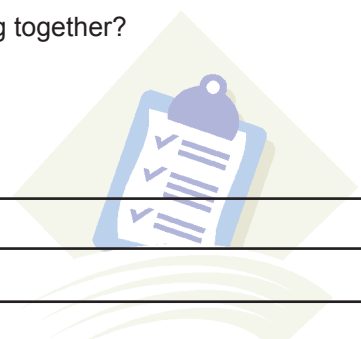

- During extended periods of the day, can children choose from a variety of available activities?
- Do kindergarteners actively exploring materials, doing hand-on activities, working and playing together?
- Are children allowed to describe what they're doing and communicate their ideas?
